

Mercedes 300 Se Manual

In 1963 the Mercedes W113 replaced two cars: the 300 SL racing legend and the successful 190 SL. In the process, the 230/250/280 SL two-seat coupe/roadster became an icon not only by carving out the perfect niche between its two predecessors, but also by being like no other car on the road. Mercedes W113 - The Complete Story explores both the technical and social side of how this legend was born. The book covers: the W113's predecessors - the 300 SL and the 190 SL; design and development of the 230, 250 and 280 SL models, including the distinctive concave 'Pagoda' roof and the 'Californian Coupe' rear seat option; Bela Barenzy's innovations that made the 230 SL the first 'safety sports car'; rallying successes for the W113; the R107 successor, with specialist advice on 'Pagoda' restorations, and the W113 in popular culture. Superbly illustrated with 249 colour photographs.

Die Analyse eines Verkehrsunfalls erfordert zusätzliches Wissen, das im Normalfall nicht während des Studiums vermittelt wird. Daher wird die Analyse von Verkehrsunfällen in der Regel von spezialisierten Sachverständigen vorgenommen. Das dazu nötige Wissen wurde Anfang der 80er Jahre bereits in einer früheren Auflage dieses Handbuchs veröffentlicht. Das Autorenteam besteht aus Experten auf ihrem jeweiligen Gebiet und stellt die Arbeitsmittel in zeitgemäßer Darstellung bereit. Dabei werden computergestützte Arbeitsmethoden berücksichtigt. Die zweite Auflage des Buches wurde um einen Abschnitt über Leitplanken

ergänzt. Neben den technischen Spezifikationen und der Projektierung fanden besonders die Bauarten für Motorradfahrer und die Testsimulation Beachtung.

El presente manual, realizado por un grupo de profesores del Departamento de Economía Financiera y Contabilidad de la Universidad de Murcia, tiene como objetivo acercar la contabilidad financiera a personas con discapacidad intelectual, mediante la elaboración de un texto que aborda la materia de manera completa y rigurosa, pero cuya redacción ha seguido las recomendaciones de InclusionEurope. Los autores del proyecto han realizado un texto que sirve de apoyo para la docencia de la asignatura de contabilidad financiera cuando está dirigida a personas con discapacidad intelectual, dividiendo la materia en 15 bloques temáticos, que abordan desde el concepto básico de contabilidad hasta la aplicación del resultado, analizando una a una las distintas problemáticas contables que cualquier alumno de contabilidad financiera debe dominar, pero salvando en la medida de lo posible, determinadas barreras existentes, como pueden ser: la dificultad para priorizar información, problemas de comprensión de enunciados complejos, déficit de comprensión de algunos dobles sentidos, o aspectos abstractos del lenguaje. El texto no trata de simplificar o reducir el contenido de la asignatura de contabilidad financiera, sino de hacerla accesible a personas con dificultades de aprendizaje, de manera que el manual abarca en profundidad todos los aspectos contables que se estudian en la materia.
